RULES TO ENTER ITALY

To the entry of athletes, coaches, judges, competition commissioners and accompanying persons it is mandatory to **take a molecular or antigenic test in the 48 hour prior the entering** on national Italian territory.

Letter of National Interest: at your entry in Italy please print a copy of the official event invitation which confirm your participation to the event as rider, coach, staff or delegate and ensure exception on the quarantine (for normal tourist a 5 days quarantine is requested) and ensure the antigenic test in 48 hours instead of 24hours.

SUPER GREEN PASS – 2G or COVID RECOVERY

From 10th January 2022, in Italy, the **Super Green Pass (also called 2G)** is **mandatory** for the access to restaurants, hotels, sport venues (including skilifts) and public transports for everyone over 12 years old. The Super Green Pass is only granted to the vaccinated and those who have recovered from the Covid-19 in the last six months.

MASKS

All the people must wear a face mask covering the nose and mouth to access the Livigno ski area.





All the athlete can take off their mask when they enter in the starting tunnel and they must put it on again at the end of the race slope.

HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE

At the moment of your arrival in Livigno evryone, riders, coaches and parents must complete the health questionnaire available at this link: <https://forms.gle/yDkMfuE9rkgpXATKA>

PERSONAL INSURANCE AND LIFT TICKETS

In order to access the lifts of the Livigno ski area, skiers have to **match the Super Green Pass with the ski pass**, before going skiing and they have to repeat the process every day. Combining the skipass with the green pass is very easy and can be done online on the [skipasslivigno.com](https://www.skipasslivigno.com) website, via the Livigno Skipassion APP or at the skipass payment machines in the area. For those who do not have a QRCode but valid documentation, the combination can be requested at any ticket office at the lifts. In case of purchase of a ski pass for under 12, the validation is done at the ticket office.

From 10th January 2022 **it is mandatory to have a a personal insurance** to ski and snowboard on Italian slopes, so everyone must have third party liability insurance.

If you don't have it you can buy it, by yourself, at the lift ticket office. No obligation to purchase it for those who already have it.

Attention, in case of inspection, for those without insurance, the legislation provides for a fine of between 100.00 and 150.00 euros and the withdrawal of the ski pass.

RACE OFFICE ACCESS

The access to race office is allowed **only to one person per team** in order to avoid any type of crowds. The team captain will collect the bibs and the lift tickets for the whole team.





Race office will be located **at Plaza Placheda**, via Saroch 1098, Livigno, and it will be open:

Saturday 15th January: 9.00 – 12.30 // 15.00 – 19.00

Sunday 16th January: 9.00 – 11.00 // 16.00 – 18.00

Monday 17th January: 16.00 – 18.00

Tuesday 18th January: 16.00 – 18.00

Wednesday 19th January: 9.00 – 12.30 // 15.00 – 19.00

Thursday 20th January: 9.00 – 11.00 // 16.00 – 18.00

Friday 21st January: 15.00 – 18.00

GENERAL COVID INFORMATIONS

For all the foreigners please check the national obligation to come back to your home country before living to Italy.

For all the foreigners athletes and coaches we also recommend to fill in the **official questionnaire of Italian Government** in order to know what are your obligations entering in Italy.
