# WORLD ROOKIE TOUR INFORMATION

All snowboarders participating in Halfpipe, & all snowboarders competing in the Antler's Alley/Stag Lane course for Slopestyle are automatically included in the Rookie & Grom Fest results. Podium finishes in the Rookie & Grom Fests automatically earn competitors a quota spot in the World Rookie Tour Finals in Kaprun. One free entry will also be given out to the top performer from the event!

Bib collection & ticketing will be available at the team captains meeting on Sunday September 30 between 1-8pm. At the Snow Sports NZ office, 78 Anderson Rd, Wanaka. #### **EVENT FORMATS & RULES**

SX/SBX: No race suits. International rules for SX & SBX clothing apply. One run time trial qualifiers. Top 25 – 50% of the field progress through to Semis & Finals (dependent on size of fields). All race protests must be made IMMEDIATELY at the race finish line or to the Chief of Course within 30 minutes of the incident.

Freeride: No man-made features allowed on course Two judged runs best run counts (straight finals) A result can be taken from the first run scores providing all competitors have completed their first run.

Halfpipe: Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals). Competitors must compete in their age group.

Slopestyle: Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals). Little Bucks - U12 (Girls), U10 & U8 age groups | Antler Alley - U12 (Boys), U14, U16, U18 age groups.

# **WEATHER POSTPONEMENTS**

Friday October 5, 2018 will be used as a weather day for any postponed events. If a day of competition is cancelled the full event schedule will shift by a day. If multiple days of competition are postponed the programme will be rescheduled to accommodate as many disciplines as possible through the week.

# POINTS CALCULATIONS FOR OVERALL INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONS:

Any athletes looking to be recognized for FIS points need to be entered via the SSNZ registration page as well as by their National Federation on the FIS Entry Form.

An Overall Individual Champion will be awarded for each age division, gender, ski & snowboard. Points are awarded based on the competitor's placing in all disciplines. A competitor must compete in all disciplines to be considered for Overall Champion in their age group (unless any discipline is cancelled). Overall Champion will be awarded to the competitor who has the most points (regardless of nationality). Points are awarded using the FIS 50-point scale below:
