



REGULATIONS GARDA ROOKIE CAMP

1. Organization

The camp is organized by **Black Yeti SSD srl** – Tax ID/VAT No. 03666570365 – Modena, Italy.

The company is affiliated with the **Italian Roller Sports Federation (FISR)** and **UISP Modena**.

The camp is officially part of the **World Rookie Tour international circuit**.

The camp is open to boys and girls practicing **skateboarding and/or BMX**.

2. Medical Certificate

Participation requires:

- for Italian athletes: a valid **non-competitive sports medical certificate**;
- for foreign athletes: equivalent medical documentation issued in their country.

Failure to provide this documentation will result in exclusion from the camp, with **no refund**.

3. Liability Waiver and Media Release

Participation is subject to the signature by a parent or legal guardian of:

- liability waiver;
- photo/video release authorization for content produced during the camp.

Failure to submit signed documents will result in exclusion from the camp.

4. Mandatory Insurance

Participants must have valid insurance coverage for:

- third-party liability (RC);
- accident insurance valid for organized skateboarding and/or BMX activities.

Insurance provided by sports organizations or federations (such as FISR or UISP) is accepted if valid and suitable. Participants are responsible for verifying their own coverage.

If not insured, participants may:

- activate their own policy;
- request a sports membership through Black Yeti SSD including insurance coverage (€30.00).



5. Supervision

- Participants will be supervised **24/7** by qualified coaches and instructors with degrees in sports science and/or extensive experience.
- Participants are **not allowed to leave the group alone** without direct supervision.

6. Age and Minimum Level

- The camp is open to participants aged **7 and above**.
- Children under 7 may be accepted only upon written request and case-by-case evaluation.
- For safety reasons, participants must have **basic experience in skateboarding or BMX**.

7. Participation Fee and Cancellation Policy

Participation fee: **€370.00**, payable:

- in full upon registration;
- or €200 deposit by July 20, 2026 and €170 balance by September 4, 2026.

Registrations without deposit by July 20, 2026 will not be considered valid.

Cancellation policy:

- Until July 20, 2026 → full refund of deposit
- July 21 – September 4, 2026 → deposit retained
- After September 4, 2026 or no-show → full fee retained

10. Code of Conduct

- Participants must follow staff instructions at all times
- **Helmet is mandatory** during all riding sessions
- Leaving the group without permission is forbidden
- Dangerous behavior is not allowed
- Respect towards others, staff, facilities and equipment is required
- Alcohol, drugs and smoking are strictly prohibited
- Damages caused by misconduct will be charged to the family
- Violation of rules may result in exclusion without refund, with return costs at the family's expense
