The already famous **Betterpark** on the top of the Hintertux glacier, well known for its autumn and spring high quality sessions, will offer the perfect set-up for 2021 **slopestyle finals**.

The event will assign the **2021 World Rookie Champions title for Snowboard and Freeski** and tons of amazing prizes: the snowboard and freeski, male and female, rookie champions will be **qualified for the 2021.22 FIS World Cup**, invitations to the 2022 Absolute Spring Battle, invitations to the WRT Shooting for the best riders of the event, many surf experience in Santander offered by SurftoLive.com, snowboard and freeski equipment offered by our sponsors Burton, Union, TSG, Blue-Tomato, Jail Jam, Volkl, Marker, Level and more.

FIS CODE As this year, due to Covid, the event will be held under FIS rules, a FIS code is mandatory. Athletes licensed starting with 2007 till 2003 are allowed to enter the event. . **RIDERS CATEGORIES** Riders, male and female, born 1st January 2003 till 2007 are admitted to World Rookie Finals. Riders will be divided in two age groups: Rookies born 2003 until 2005 - Groms 2006 and 2007 WORLD ROOKIE RANK For Snb are admitted the Top 20 riders of the World Rookie Rank (top 20 male, top 20 female) + the top 10 riders from the Grom rank by the 16th of April. National quota for WSF Members allowed to get 5 spots example: 2 Rookies Men, 1 Rookie Girl, 1 Grom Men, 1 Grom Girl (or other combinations) WORLD ROOKIE TOUR EVENTS . The Top 3 riders, (both Male and Female / Rookie and Grom) from every WRT Stop from Season 2019/20 and 2020/21 are already gualified to the World Rookie Finals. National secretary or national coaches are allowed to send their team inscriptions.

For missing BIBS € 20 will be invoiced to each NSA after the competition. All competitors have to wear helmets through official training, qualification and finals.
Accident Protocol:	In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital
Anti-Doping:	Anti-Doping control may be deducted.

COVID-19 PRECISIONS

Dear team captains. Please read through the following rules very carefully. These regulations are established by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Health, Austrian Ski Federation and the LOC in cooperation with FIS. It is your responsibility to inform your entire team and make sure all members follow these rules without exceptions.

- 1. What is important:
 - Take personal responsibility very serious
 - hygiene measures at all times (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)
 - maintain a minimum distance of 2 meter in all areas (social distancing)
 - wear FFP2 Masks at all times
 - o on the entire event site, except
 - during the practice of sport
 - in the start area right before the start
 - o inside all buildings
 - o for all transports in buses, shuttles, gondolas, chair lifts
 - o in the common areas of your accommodation
- 2. COVID-19 tests:

•

- Everybody (athletes, coaches and staff) who wants to get an accreditation for the event needs to present a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or Antigen not older than 72 hours before the start of training). The negative test result must be presented when collecting the accreditations.
 - Accreditation for persons with a previously diagnosed COVID-19 infection
 - present the PCR COVID-19 positive test result made between 2 weeks and 3 months before the arrival
 - \circ free of COVID-19 symptoms for a minimum of 3 days before arrival
- **3.** Daily Health Questionnaire for athletes, coaches and LOC: Daily Health Questionnaire for athletes, coaches and LOC: will follow latest on 16.04.2021
 - has to be filled out and sent online mandatory every morning before showing up at the bottom station of the gondola (will be controlled) Starting with the first day of training. Latest Monday morning the 26.04.2021
- 4. Team Captains Meeting (TCM): Online via Zoom Meeting. Will Follow
- 5. Transportation rules for cars/team busses:
 - max two people can be carried in each row of seats
 - wearing FFP2 mask is mandatory
- 6. Rules for Hotel/Accomodation:
 - professional athletes and coaches are allowed to stay in hotels, closed for the public
 - FFP2 mask mandatory, except at the table while meals
- 7. Transportation rules for gondola/chairlift:
 - checkpoint bottom station for the correct questionnaire by the COVID-19 Manager
 - FFP2 masks mandatory for gondola, possibility to get one at the bottom station
 - FFP2 mask for chairlift
 - half capacity at all times
 - staggered, team by team

- 8. Avoid crowds: inspection, toilets, gondola, chairlift
 - spend your free time only with members of your team in small groups
- 9. COVID-19 Communication
 - in case of COVID-19 symptoms immediately inform the COVID-19 Manager who is responsible for the Event – Stefan Ebner – <u>stefan.ebner@scibk.at</u> / +43 650 9096020
 - COVID-19 Manager activates the necessary COVID-19 measures all communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with LOC and FIS

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR AUSTRIA

Dear all,

due to Covid-19 pandemic, new measures to contain the Covid-19 virus have been tightened. The regulation came into force with Friday, 15.01.2021 means that entry into Austria is from that on only possible under the following conditions:

- From Friday, 15.01.2021 on all persons entering Austria are engaged to register through the "Pre-Travel-Clearance-Form" (also mandatory for children!).
- The registration has done upon arrival online link: • to be via the following https://www.formularservice.gv.at/site/fsrv/user/formular.aspx?pid=15dd7f9c98c24952828eb414c88 84f1a&pn=Bfd027cf662624276a5ca9a9b970bcdf9&lang=en After your successful registration you will get a copy as well as a QR-Code. This serves as your backup for potential boarder-controls. Furthermore a negative PCR or antigen Test (not older than 72 hours) is mandatory and also the attached certificate by a doctor needs to be uploaded via the online registration (see annex D "Medical certificate")
- When entering Austria from abroad, a quarantine of 10 days after entry is obligatory. This quarantine is not relevant if you are competing / working at
 - Worldcup or Europacup competitions in Austria with National Interest and if you have a copy of the letter from the Federal Ministry with you. This exception is only valid for registered participants as well as for anyone required behind the scenes for Worldcup and Europacup competitions.

- Summing up you what you need for you travel to Austria:
 - Online registration as described above upon arrival
 - Invitation letter from the Austrian ministry (available through the LOC)
 - Confirmation, that you are professional Athlete (from your Ski Association)
 - Negative antigen / PCR Test not older than 72 hours certified by a doctor (see attached)

Data Protection to all Covid-measures:

The personal information provided is treated strictly confidentially by the Local Organizing Committee and Austrian Ski Federation (OESV). It will only be used for the purpose of assessing whether the applicant can be granted or maintain accreditation in view of the COVID-19 outbreak. In case the local and national public health department need your data we will provide them with all information. Otherwise all datas will be deleted after 28 days.
